



## Putting and Green Reading Page 2

5 Shots Green Reading, 15 ft, L to R 2ft br, L to R 6-12in br, Straight, R to L 6-12in br, R to L 2ft br, See Notes Below



On a practice putting green, you are looking for 5 different breaking putts. Each putt will

be approximately 15 feet in length. You are looking for:

- 1.) Severe left-to-right breaking putt (at least 2 feet of break)
- 2.) Slight left-to-right breaking putt (about 6 to 12 inches of break)
- 3.) Straight putt (break not outside the cup)
- 4.) Slight right-to-left breaking putt (about 6 to 12 inches of break)
- 5.) Severe right-to-left breaking putt (at least 2 feet of break)

Do the best you can at locating these putt descriptions, and place a ball on the green for each putt (5 balls on the green).

Next, you are going to "guess the break" of each of these putts and write down the exact amount of break you would play (do not putt the balls, just go from one putt to the next and document your five reads).

Next, to get the True Break of each putt, you will need the help of the Pelz Putting Tutor.

Super-pro setting. Stroke putts and adjust the aim of the Tutor until you are making putts at good speed. Now see where the Putting Tutor is aiming relative to the hole, and measure the true break of each putt (refer to Dave Pelz Putting Bible pg 144). Write down the True Break of each putt.

## Scoring system:

For each of the five putts, if your "guess break" is: within 2 inches of the "true break" = 4 points between 2 to 4 inches of the "true break" = 2 points between 4 to 6 inches of the "true break" = 1 point outside 6 inches of the "true break" = 0 points
