

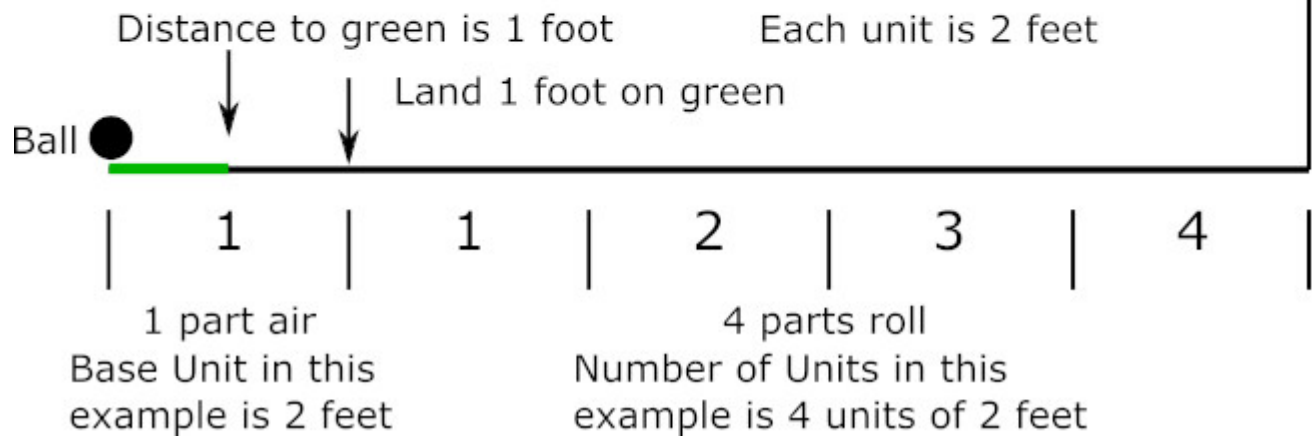
# Paul Runyan "Rule of 12"

## Printable Charts

Object: Land the ball on the flattest & closest dry place on the green

The correct choice in this example would be 8 iron  
Using a regular putting stroke 1:4 ratio or  $12-4=8$

Maximum ground time and minimum air time  
10 total feet - base unit 2 feet and (4) 2 foot units



There are two ways to look at this

12 minus number of units = club	or Club	Ratio ( Air to Roll)
12 - 1 = Sand Wedge	Sand wedge	1 : 1
12 - 2 = Pitching wedge	Pitching Wedge	1 : 2
12 - 3 = 9 iron	9 iron	1 : 3
12 - 4 = 8 iron	8 iron	1 : 4
12 - 5 = 7 iron	7 iron	1 : 5
12 - 6 = 6 iron	6 iron	1 : 6
12 - 7 = 5 iron	5 iron	1 : 7
12 - 8 = 4 iron or hybrid	4 iron	1 : 8
12 - 9 = 3 iron or hybrid	3 iron	1 : 9
12 - 10 = 2 iron or 5 wood		
12 - 11 = 3 wood		
12 - 12 = Driver		

There aren't many times you will get passed using a 3 iron or hybrid
