This graphic illiustrates a typical breaking putt The Aim Point is "where to aim" The aim line is the line tangent to the trajectory The green dotted line is the trajectory or true break Aim Point DO NOT aim at the Apex of the Trajectory The result would be missing low Aim Line Trajectory Ball 1/3 2/3Hole Baseline Apex

According to putting expert Phil Kenyon
There is a useful reference at 2/3 of the way to the hole
That is where you could predict the aim line
It would be 2 times the distance from the "baseline"
to the "trajectory" (Noted as 1 & 2 above)
